Welcome to Locust Valley Golf Club. Once a country club, this 18-hole course in Coopersburg, Pennsylvania features 6,504 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 72. The course rating is 72.2 and it has a slope rating of 133 on Rye grass. Designed by William F. Gordon, ASGCA, the Locust Valley golf course opened in 1954. Only minutes south of Allentown, east of Bethlehem and north of Quakertown, the course is easily accessible from the I-78 and just off Route 309. Reading is just 35 minutes to the west, the New Jersey border is just 15 minutes away and it only 45 minutes to Philadelphia or the Poconos.

# Tournament Rates & Options

## **Tournament Options**

We can accommodate shotgun events from 80 to a full field of 144. We can offer shotgun starts for less players, by allowing a few holes to remain open for outside play. The total number of golfers participating in the outing will determine the number of holes (Minimum 40 golfers). Any group that falls below a count of 40 golfers may be converted into a Tee Time Outing. Also, the entire golf course can be rented for the day, to allow for events of over 200 golfers.

## **Charity Outing – Donated food and beverage**

If you are running a charity event, and may have donated food and beverage, please speak with our Tournament Director for special consideration. We understand that some events are fundraisers for various charities and causes and will be happy to work with you to make your event a success. Not-for-profits who intend on using donated beverages must have certification from the beverage distributor. Locust Valley abides by all State Liquor Authority laws and we will do our best to accommodate within these regulations.

# Helpful Planning Tips

We want every tournament at Locust Valley Golf Club to be wildly successful, and after hosting hundreds of events, we have learned a few things about what separates a successful event from the others.

## **Maximize Player Participation**

The single most important key to a successful tournament is to maximize the number of participants. Locust Valley Golf Club is priced so charities can actually make money on each golfer, rather than just break even. Consequently, hosting more players means more revenue from golf alone, in addition to a more profitable auction or raffle, and a better opportunity for prospective hole sponsors and other donors. Here are some tips that have proven effective in maximizing participation:

- Start early – there are many tournaments out there, so the sooner you can get commitments, the better.
- It is by far the most labor-intensive way, but also the cheapest and most effective –call golfers directly. It guarantees that the message is delivered, and makes it difficult for them to say no.
- Free press in the local papers is great, but we do not recommend paying for advertising. The cost cuts into your bottom line, and ads are easily ignored.
- If at all possible, try to get golfers to pay ahead of time. This cuts down greatly on no-shows and makes life much easier for tournament organizers the day of the event. Most golfers have no idea how much work goes into tournament organization – let them know how much help it would be to pay up front.
- Show the golfers a good time so they come back year after year.
- Write thank you notes to all sponsors and team captains. A little note can go a long way to separate your event from all the others.

# Helpful Planning Tips cont.

## **Sponsors:**

Sponsors will be your greatest source of net income. There is really no end to the opportunities for sponsorship, including: holes (or even tee and green), practice green, golf carts, longest drive and closest to the pin contests, hole-in-ones, beverage cart, lunch or dinner, prizes, auction, and title or tournament sponsor. Donations for raffles or silent auctions will also generate revenue that will go directly to your charity.



## **Contests, Games, and Other Money Makers:**

There is no limit – be creative. Here are some examples that have worked well:

- Closest to the pins and Pot of Gold (holes 6, 9, 13 and 17), long drive #7 and straightest drive #14. To give more participants a chance to win, you can also offer a shortest drive and a longest putt made. You won't need to do a thing except provide prizes, we'll handle the rest.
- 50-50 Raffle for hitting the green. Everyone who hits the green gets entered in a drawing where the winner gets 50% of the proceeds of the raffle. You'll need 1 or 2 people to sit on a certain hole during the tournament and ask golfers to participate.
- Mulligans – Mulligans will slow down pace of play, however they are pure profit. Please limit golfers to 2 mulligans each. You'll need a couple of people to sell mulligans when golfers check-in.

# Tournament Rules & Regulations

All golf outings must abide by the following rules:

## **Confirmation of Event**

The event is confirmed once a Tournament Information Sheet has been signed. If the Tournament Information Sheet is not returned to Locust Valley Golf Club, the outing can be cancelled.

## **Deposit and Guarantees:**

All Golf tournaments require a \$200 non-refundable deposit to hold space and tee times for your event. Guaranteed numbers for your golfers and food and beverage are due fourteen (14) days in advance of your tournament with a 20% deposit. Final payment is due the day of the event. Please state if your group is tax exempt when booking your event.

## **Cancellation Policy**

Cancellations must be received at least 14 days prior to the outing.

## **Golf Cart/Golf Clubs**

Golf carts are required for all players. Only 2 riders and 2 bags will be allowed per cart. No one under 16 years of age will be allowed to operate golf carts. The group is responsible for the use of the golf carts and will be charged for any damage to these carts during the outing. Each player must have a set of golf clubs. Club rentals are available on a first come, first serve basis. If sets are required, you should inform the Pro shop several days in advance at an additional cost of \$5 per set.

## **Other Services**

- Contact the Golf Shop to make any special arrangements such as closest to the pin or long drive contests.
- Gift certificates are available and may be added to the “master bill” of the event.
- Specialty logo items may be ordered through our golf shop. Contact Pro Shop at (610) 282-4711 for ordering details and pricing. Allow at least a 30-60 day lead time for delivery.

**Beverages** must be purchased from Locust Valley Golf Club. Donated Non-Alcoholic Beverages for Charity Outings may be allowed at the discretion of the Locust Valley General Manager. (Per person charge will be added for outside food and outside beverages).
